The 3 windows across the front are centrally located between the 3 doors. There are 3 interior brick chimneys and an outside staircase is to be added.</p> <p>42. History and Significance Built by a man named Chute, it was originally a Drug Company on the ground floor and a dance pavillion on the second level. It was moved to its present location in 1910. Its significance lies in its early commercial architectural style.</p> <p>43.
