DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Gafford-Hartley-Mullins House in rural Butler County is a single-story frame structure with a shallowly pitched pyramidal roof built in the Greek Revival style.

Basically square in plan, the structure has a symmetrical five-bay facade composed of four 9/6 double-hung sash windows and a double-leaf paneled central main entrance framed by sidelights and transom. The full-width recessed portico has a plain entablature resting on six square wooden columns.

Alterations to the structure are minimal. At an unspecified date, asbestos shingle siding was added to the exterior, but does not detract from the lines of the building or cover original architectural elements.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Gafford-Hartley-Mullins House in rural Butler County is a well-preserved example of a Greek Revival cottage. The building was constructed by Daniel Gafford, and was transferred to T. G. Hartley in 1900. Hartley was related to the Gafford family by marriage. The property was sold to R. Z. Mullins in 1936, and in 1976 was passed to the current owner.
