DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This home is of the Greek Revival style of architecture and stands on a hill overlooking LaFayette Street. Both upper and lower stories have large rooms on each side of a central hall. The front and sides of the house have open porches. Two pair of triple Ionic columns dominate the front of the house and the pattern is repeated along the porch.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Greek Revival architecture was very popular in the period that this home was built.

Senator Tom Heflin married Miss Minnie Schuessler and built this home around 1912.

Senator Heflin spent twenty years in Washington and became distinguished for his personality, ability as a speaker and for his sense of humor. His unswerving devotion to the interests of his constituents earned him the nickname "Cotton Tom."

The home is presently owned by the Lynn Callahan family.

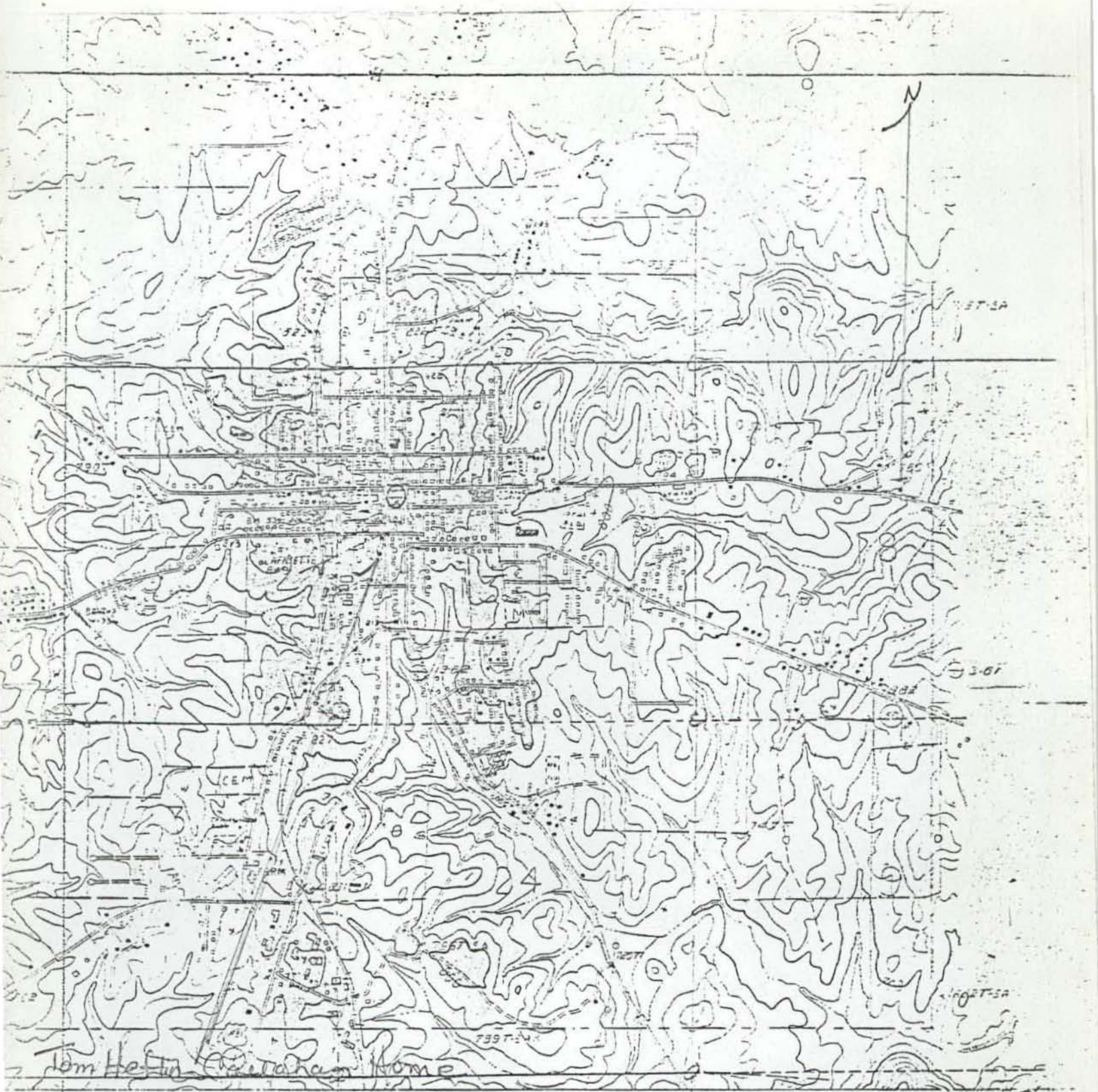
