The water tower, located at the side of a street in Lineville, is constructed of concrete in a most unusual fashion. The structure is 100 feet tall and appears to be hollow on the interior. Wide at the bottom, the tower tapers at the top, but then widens into what resembles a sentry tower of medieval castles. There is a wrought iron door at the bottom. Unfortunately, people have thrown debris through the door into the lower level of the tower and it appears to be quite raunchy.

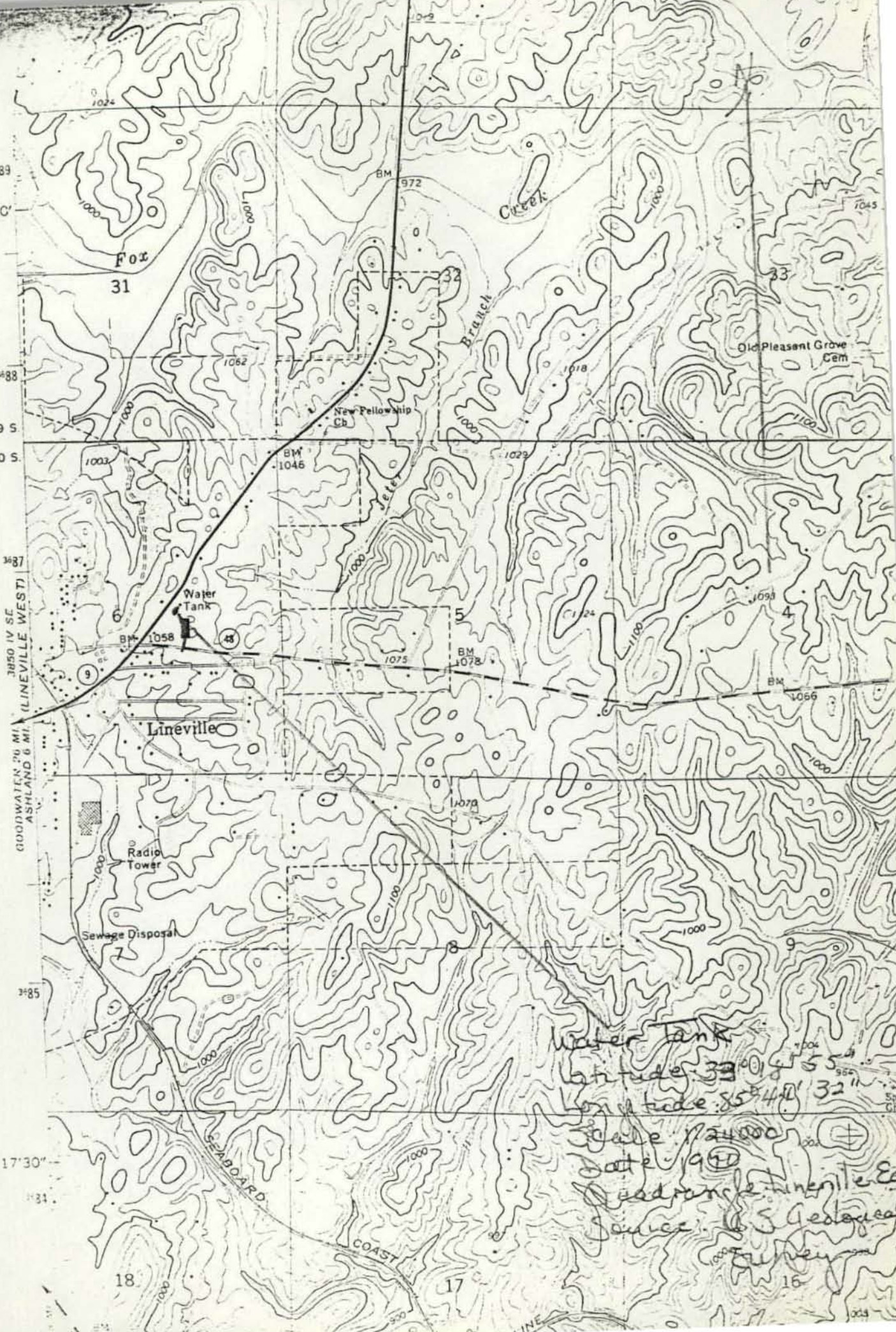

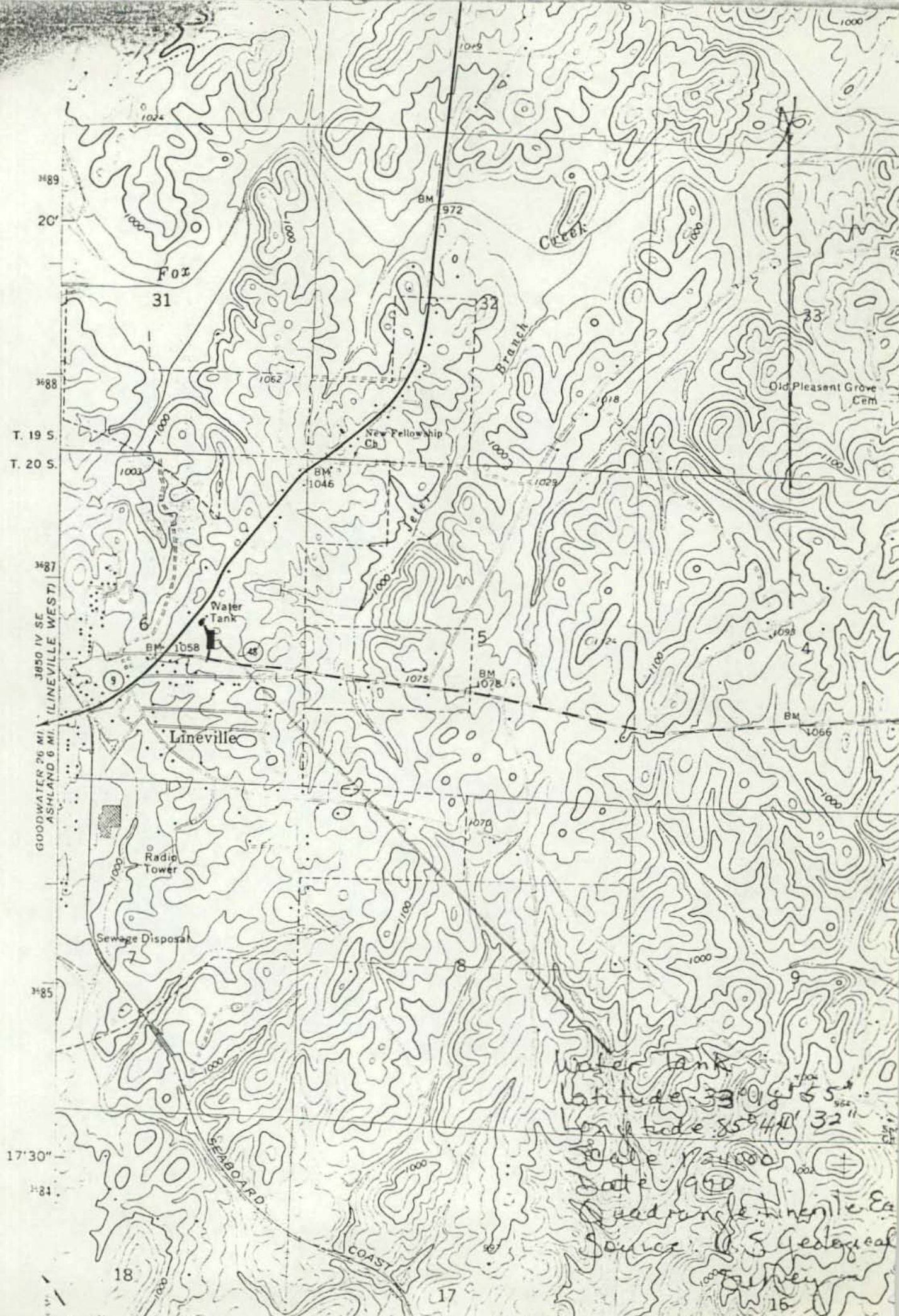

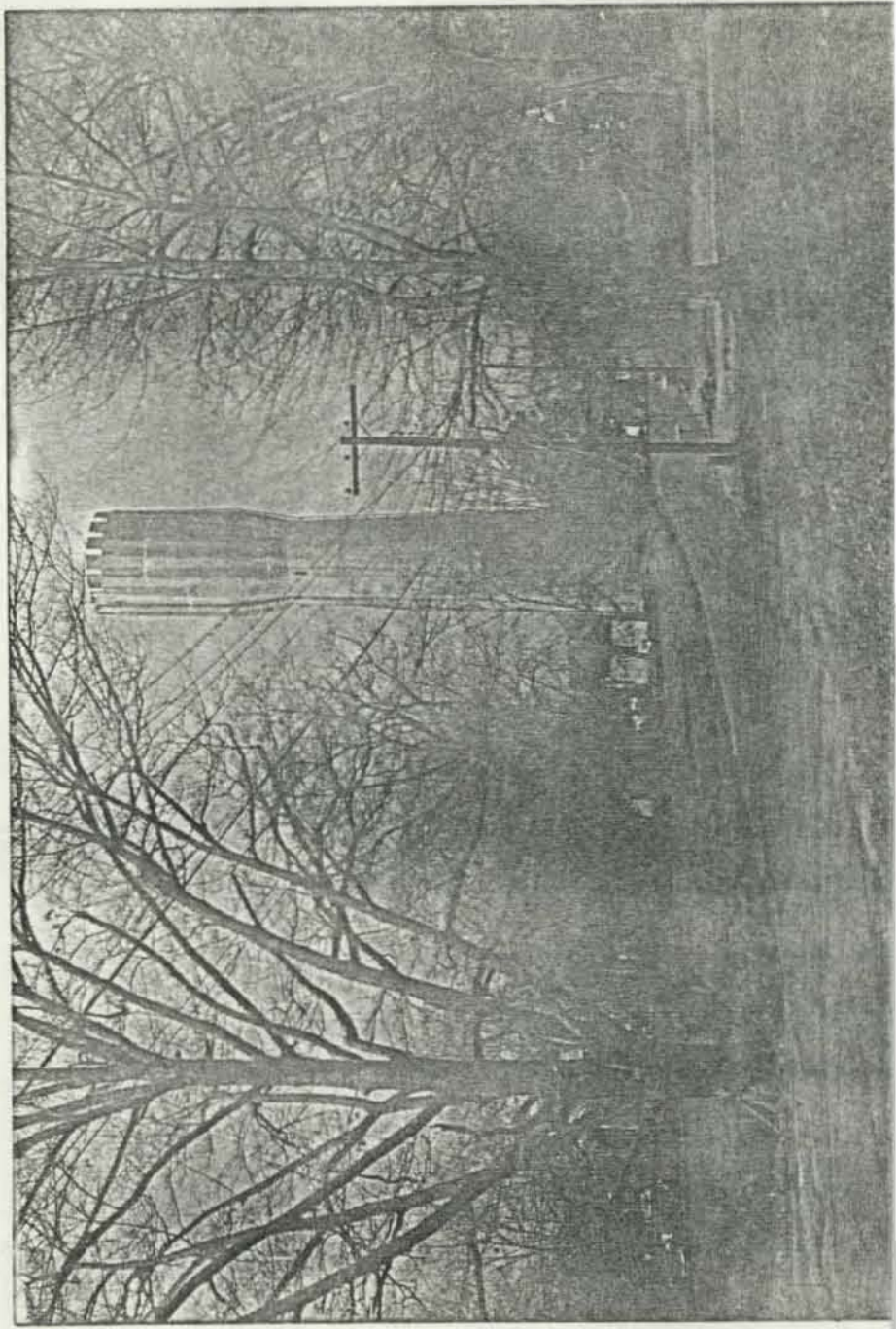
