Group Tour Experiences



We offer engaging guided tours tailored for your needs and interests in Montgomery's fully ADA-accessible Historic Greyhound Bus Station.

All groups learn about the 1961 Civil Rights campaign to integrate inter-state travel, and the hundreds of Freedom Riders who risked everything for it.

Younger visitors learn about justice, bravery, and music in the Movement. Older youth and adult groups focus on nonviolent direct action, student activism, and roles of state and federal government in the long Civil Rights Movement.

The museum tour consists of **10-15 minute guided overview** followed by another 30 minute self guided time for visitors to ask questions, engage in discussion, and explore our art and history exhibits. Please schedule at least one hour for group tour visits to the museum. We also offer virtual tours. Call or email the museum for details on the museum virtual tours. Please note that admission rates apply for virtual tours as well.



We also have a **gift shop** with t-shirts, buttons, books, and other items to celebrate and learn more about the Freedom Rides and Civil Rights.

Group Admission, Payment & Guidelines

Discounted Group Admission

Rates apply for groups of 10 or more only

Adults	\$4 each
Seniors (age 65+), Military, College	\$3 each
Youths (age 6-18)	\$2 each
K-12 staff with their students	Free
Children (age 0-5)	Free
