ALABAMA NATIONAL REGISTER REVIEW BOARD

At its meeting on April 22, 2021, the Alabama National Register Review Board considered the four nominations listed below and recommended that they be submitted to the National Park Service for official listing in the National Register of Historic Places.

- Atmore Commercial Historic District, Atmore, Escambia County – LISTED June 18, 2021
- Magnolia Hall, Greensboro, Hale County – LISTED June 25, 2021
- Edmonton Heights Historic District, Huntsville, Madison County – LISTED June 21, 2021
- Water Avenue Historic District (Boundary Increase and Additional Documentation), Selma, Dallas County [location partially restricted] – LISTED June 25, 2021

The Alabama National Register Review Board will hold its next meeting on **September 23, 2021 at 10:30 am** in the Carriage House at the Alabama Historical Commission. More information about the meeting and the nominations to be considered will be posted in August. The meeting is open to the public.

WHAT HAPPENS AT A REVIEW BOARD MEETING?

The author of each nomination gives a brief (5-10 minute) presentation on the property. The members of the Review Board then discuss the nomination and vote on whether to forward the nomination to the National Park Service for designation.

After the board has reviewed the nominations, the National Register Coordinator provides a brief update on the National Register program in Alabama.
